What went well?

- Effective networking and cooperation of partners though limitations due to COVID-19 Pandemic.
- The services of reproductive health and counselling were provided to the targeted groups.
- Parents were able to collect their child contraceptives through the refilling procedures.
- Provided counselling one to one and by phone.
- Psychosocial support were provided to the vulnerable and other groups.

What went less well?

- Drop outs.
- Access to the school compound was restricted both Secondary and Post secondary.
- Decrease in number of talks at school level due COVID-19 Pandemic.
- Limitations and restrictions of outsiders on the school premises.

What can we do to improve the HIV, AIDS & Viral Hepatitis response?

- Increase youth access to the use of condoms.
- Creative ways to pass on information -; Role plays, videos
- Social media -; Facebook, WhatsApp, Instagram, TV, Radio
- Increase more Youth friendly services/approach
- Safe and conducive environment
- Confidentiality
- Decentralisation of services offered
- Accessible spot for condom distributions









Way forward

- Parenting sessions to sensitize parents about the different available services.
- Sexual related topics should be introduced earlier in the school curriculum.
- Training for Peer Educators.
- Sponsorship for face masks, flavored condoms for youths.
- Effective networking amongst partners.
